## Education system

The education system of this university is based on international education methods such as the USA, UK and so on. The academic year has 02 (two) semesters-Spring, and Fall. The undergraduate degree is of four years duration. In every semester students take assigned courses. Each course consists of 3/4 credits. Students have to successfully complete certain credits definite for each program and degree requirements to obtain the degree with minimum CGPA 2.50. Initially the university started with Bachelor programs only and now it is offering a Master program as well. Master programs are of one or two years. The university offers some special courses, diploma and certificate courses for the professional workers. Diploma holders with outstanding results have opportunities for higher studies in any local or foreign university. The medium of instruction of this university is English.




Figure 1: Growth of student enrolment from 2015 to 2021




Figure 2: Growth of International student enrolment from 2015 to 2021




Figure 3: Growth of Faculty Members from 2015 to 2021




Figure 4: Growth of Administrative Support from 2015 to 2021




Figure 5: Growth of Number of Approved Programs from 2015 to 2021




Figure 6: Growth of Foreign collaboration from 2015 to 2021

# Campuses


Daffodil International University, Daffodil Smart City (DSC), Ashulia, Dhaka.

The campus is situated at Daffodil Smart City, Ashulia, Dhaka. The land area is around 70 acres. The location is easily accessible from any part of Dhaka City. All sorts of transports including bus, auto rickshaw, etc. are available from the location and towards the location.

Daffodil International University (DIU) has a long-cherished dream to establish a campus with all modern and latest educational facilities. The seed of dream had been sown when on June 20, 2010 DIU initially purchased 12 Acres of land at 'Ashulia Sarnali Project' (near Uttara), Savar, Dhaka for building its own campus. The seed of a dream had started to sprout on 10th February 2011, one of the historic days for DIU, when all of the DIU members visited the campus.

Professor Nazrul Islam, Honorable Chairman, UGC laid the foundation-stone on that day which commenced the construction work of the much-awaited campus of DIU.

The campus has individual Faculty and Administrative infrastructure, Residential Hall, Library, Food Court, Food Garden, TSC, Auditorium, Playground, Swimming Pool, Mosque, Bonomaya, Anisul Haque Study Center, Innovation Lab, Gymnasium, departmental faculties and an ICT centre. The campus consists of modern facilities for lectures, meetings, group activities, student organizations and religious festivals. It will fully be equipped with medical facilities, Psychological service, science laboratories and performance spaces and many more.



DIU envisages turning the campus into a 100% Fiber Optic Network and Wifi enabled. For ensuring all sorts of facilities there will be on-campus shopping facilities which will be run only by students so that they may avail themselves of part time jobs and earn money while studying. Residential halls have been constructed for students. All the departments are now running in our green campus.

It has separate academic and administrative infrastructures and residential halls. Mega events are held on a regular basis. Students in this campus have recently launched a Green Movement for keeping this campus free from all sorts of pollution. BioGas plant, massive plantation, deer feeding, solar energy infrastructure and a large cycling track are some of the features of the green movement of DIU.

A 6000-seat auditorium with all modern facilities, a 100-seat mini hall with electronic writing board, Media Lab, Mobile Apps Development Research Lab and an Innovation Lab, facilities for indoor games, Lounges, Digital classrooms, Gymnasium, Medical Center, Café, Large transport pool, Standard Football and Cricket grounds, English language lab, MCT Lab, Golf drive, practice range and a Startup market have made this campus an attractive location for education and recreation for all.

A rich library with a huge collection of books, e-books, journals and e-journals, computer labs, science labs, textile labs, a lucrative auditorium and many more.

DIU campus is approximately 25 minutes away from the city nucleus. Four routes can be used for this location through- 1) Gaabtolli i.e Dhaka-Aricha highway, 2) Uttara i.e Airport Road, 3) Mazar road, Mirpur, and 4) Rokeya Sarani, Mirpur. DIU Transport System is ensuring movement of the students and teachers from Dhaka city to the Daffodil Smart City campus.

The master plan for the campus has been designed by an internationally renowned architectural firm. Most of the campus construction has already been completed. The campus has a world-class facility, ensuring quality education, security, peace and comfort.




# Research and World University Rankings



# Global Presence & International Affairs



## Office of the International Affairs

It's an independent counseling station for students to relate to the international educational arena. The International Affairs (IA) office helps with international students who want to study in DIU, and also works on creating opportunities for DIU students to internationalize them through joining short term and semester exchange programs. The International Affairs office is the information center for overseas institutions that are interested in working with DIU. Office of the International Affairs do arrange the following regular support to students and staffs connecting with global partners:

### Student Exchange Programs

IA Office has been processing and maintaining the exchange program since 2013. Students of DIU can choose any partner university to complete their one semester to one year's courses without paying any tuition fee to partner universities under student exchange program. At the same time, a good number of students from different partner universities do attend DIU for one semester exchange program. Access to the program is not limited to Asia but to any other country in the world.

### Scholarships:

Each year a good number of students from DIU join different countries under ERASMUS+ scholarship program in European countries, CCI Scholarship in the United States, Mevlana Scholarship program in Turkey, KGSP in Korea, MEXT Scholarship in Japan, KNB Scholarship in Indonesia, Study in India, Scholarship in Canada Scholarship and many more. DIU students have been to many different countries such as UK, Poland, Portugal, Turkey, Lithuania, Greece, Italy, and Belgium under different scholarships.

### Summer/Winter Camp:

Every year the IA office organizes a one or 2 weeks long

Cross-cultural exchange program, as the summer or winter camp of DIU. Students from different countries like China, Taiwan, Indonesia, Philippines, India, Sri Lanka and more are coming to DIU to have cross-cultural and leadership learning experiences. Participants from SIAS International University exchanged their educational and cultural activities with DIU students during the winter camp every year since 2018. Apart from that students from Sri Lanka, Taiwan, and India are coming regularly to know more about SDG, Social Business, Leadership etc. The program has several fun activities, field visits, exploring Dhaka city and observing the lifestyle of the people of Bangladesh.

### International Social Business Summer Program (ISBSP):

It is an excellent summer school program, organized by the IA Office focusing on the social business concept of Nobel Laureate Professor Mohammad Yunus. Since 2017 IA office has been organizing this program every year. This program is held in the first week of July, and each year almost 50-60 students join this program from different countries in the world. ### Short Term Programs:

IA office nominates and accepts students, faculty members and admin officers for international short-term programs like Asia Summer Program, ELC Summer Camp, Global Entrepreneurship Camp, CommTECH summer Camp, KIIT-KISS Internship program, Fellowship, Global Student Leadership Program etc in Asia, Europe and other parts of the world. Besides, DIU hosts Asia Leadership Camp, Youth4SDG program, Youth Exchange program with neighboring countries etc.

## Online/Virtual Program:

IA office is organizing numerous virtual programs concerning the COVID-19 pandemic situation. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, students' physical mobility to foreign universities has been restricted but we are connecting our students globally through virtual mobility. The Office of the International Affairs is organizing virtual E-talk sessions, webinars, e-Master Class, COIL in collaboration with foreign universities and professionals; and providing international opportunities to the students.

## Faculty Exchange Program:

We nominate faculty members as visiting lecturers who are interested in international exchange programs for at least a few weeks or max. 2 months periods of time; and accept visiting lecturers to our university at different departments from partner universities to teach. For the Incoming faculty exchange program we take the responsibility of local hospitality like accommodation, food, local transport, office, etc. In most cases it's also remain same for the outgoing faculties of DIU.

## International Partnership and Linkages:

DIU signs MoUs and MoAs with different institutions with a view to mutual collaboration in exchanges, seminars and workshops; and the office of international Affairs facilitates that procedure. DIU is highly focused on international collaborations, and by now International Affairs Office has affiliated with around 450 universities all over the world, and member of more than 52 leading international organizations like AUPF, IIE, IAU, IAUP, AUAP, ACU, ALA, ACD, Magna Charta, UNAI, APAIE, EURAS, ESRUC, EEUA, ATUNET, IEEE, ISTQB, ACE, NAFSA, AMDISA, EAIE, ATIFTAF, ITU, ACBSP, UNGC, UMAP, IFLA, WUACD, GUNI, SDSN, ASEF, AIESEC, ASECU, IETI, Future Team, SDG Helpdesk, EEUA etc.

With our global partners, we are mutually working in the area of student and faculty exchange programs, scholarships, summer and winter programs, international internship, research collaborations, short-term training programs, etc.



# General FEATURE



## Aims of Higher Education

The university is meant to provide education to its students to prepare them for the responsibilities of being administrators, entrepreneurs, teachers and professionals. It is the gateway to higher research and implementation of new technologies and ideas. In a world that is increasingly becoming more and more dependent on information, it is the universities that can play key roles in making sure that students understand the advancement of knowledge and can acquire this knowledge and utilise it in their work for the development of the country.

Universities themselves can serve as the dynamic institutes that can generate new technologies and knowledge necessary for the transformation of a society. In low and middle income countries investment in higher education can lead to social returns of 10% by some estimates, which in turn means that these investments lead to increase in labour productivity and higher long term growth.

## Degrees Awarded by DIU

DIU offers degrees in all branches of Business & Entrepreneurship, Engineering, Allied Health Science, Humanities and Social Sciences and Science & Information Technology. Degrees are awarded at the undergraduate as well as graduate level. The university is offering a four-year Bachelor's degree and one-two years Master degree in a number of programs. Also DIU is offering Post Graduate Diploma. As the university grows and an institutional capacity is built up, the degrees are being awarded in a larger number of disciplines.

DIU is offering different programs under the Faculty of Business & Entrepreneurship, Faculty of Science & Information Technology, Faculty of Engineering, Faculty of Allied Health Science and the Faculty of Humanities and Social Science. DIU wants quality students to get admitted here who have successfully completed their primary and secondary education i.e SSC/ O-Level/ Dakhil & HSC/A-Level/ Alim/ Diploma or equivalent.

## Advising, Internships, Daffodil Network and Link Programs

When students first join the university, they will be assigned a freshman advisor who will help them in choosing their courses for the first year. In their sophomore year, students will seek an adviser who will then be responsible for guiding their choice of course. Students will develop the direction of their study in consultation with their adviser.

A feature of the university is internship programs that expose students to work settings in industry and development. Given Daffodil's wide range of development activities and wide network of its offices and training centers around the country, it is possible for students to work all around the country and study different aspects of these areas.

The university has a linkage program with educational institutions both inside and outside of Bangladesh. As mentioned before Daffodil itself has collaborated with many research organizations and educational institutions at home and abroad. The university already established some linkage programs with different universities of different countries like USA, UK, Sweden, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, China, India and Malaysia. It is helping the students of DIU to transfer the credits to those universities and making a partnership in the form of collaboration and research between DIU and the concerned university.

## Naming and Numbering the Courses

Credit hours are calculated on a time basis of a 18-week semester. One credit means that the course meets for once a week (50 minutes period). 3 credit means that the course would meet three times per week (50 minutes each period). Laboratory courses of three credits would meet the equivalent of three times per week (110 minutes each period).

## The Credit Hour System

The academic system of study at DIU is based on credit hours. A credit hour normally represents one theoretical hour a week. Three credit hours means the course will be taught weekly three hours i.e three lessons of an hour each in a week for a particular course. The study spans over two academic semesters, each consists of 18 weeks.

## Campus Based Instruction

Campus based instructional mode is to follow the usual practice of classroom lectures and interactions, practical exercises, assignments and class room tests. This is in line with a full credit hour system. In this connection, a reasonable emphasis is given on participation in the class, participation in practical works at field level, completing assignments and appearing in the class tests





## Faculty And Resource Persons

DIU employs well qualified faculty and persons of resource for its educational purposes from local and foreign countries as per the rules and regulations for campus based education. Both full-time and part-time faculty members are appointed. The experience of distance learning education in the present world suggests, however, that its faculty may be in a location far from the venue of the institution that provides distance education, since regular classroom instruction is not required in this mode of education. This is an additional advantage since it provides the flexibility to choose well-qualified and experienced faculty from different places locally and internationally.

## Curriculum Content and Evaluation

Curricula are central to the implementation of degree programs. Creating and delivering high quality curricula requires planning and evaluation. Similar academic objectives may be achieved through curricula with different structures and approaches. Undergraduate IT & Business curricula provide a board context within which education for business is set. These curricula combine general education and basic study of IT & Business.

Master's curricula in IT & Business provide a distinctly professional perspective. Master's of Business Administration (MBA) degree programs prepare students with a general managerial perspective. IT Specialized Master's curriculum prepares students who seek specialized roles in IT & Business, IT based Business management and related professions.

## Curriculum

The curricula for the Daffodil International University have evolved in order to respond to the demand of the time. However the curriculum has been developed as broad based, relevant to Bangladesh, with the help of experts in relevant fields.

## English Language and Literature

The study of English is extremely important for global significance as an international medium of communication. English is a language that is widely used in South Asia and a rich volume of English is being written by South Asian authors. In the context of Bangladesh, English is crucial for keeping in touch with advances in science and technology in the world. DIU has the largest English department in the country, providing various courses in language, linguistics, and literature. With highly experienced and very well-qualified members of faculty, the English department is very popular among students of both Bangladesh and foreign countries.





# Academic Rules and **Regulations**

## Registration

Students are required to complete their registration formalities within the duration announced by the university. After consulting their course advisors, students must register themselves in courses which they decide to take in each semester. Students must pay a late fee of Tk. 500/- for late registration and If a student fails to pay the fees within the next schedule you must pay a late fee of Tk. 1000/- and Tk. 200/- for late installment payments before examinations.

If any student decides not to register for next semester(s), he/she must inform the university well ahead of the start of a semester by using a specified form which is available in ERP software. On failure of informing through proper process, a student will have to pay Tk. 1,000/- (Taka one thousand) as compensation per semester during the time of his/her next registration for a semester.

## Registration Procedure

For registration, the student must pay the registration fees and previous dues (if there is any) to the accounts section to get an account's clearance.

The student will meet the course advisor and with the consent of the advisor write the names of the course(s) he/she intends to take for the semester.

The course advisor makes the input for the selected courses in the ERP system for the next four months.

## Transfer from other University

Students meeting the minimum admission requirements and with good academic results from other recognized universities can transfer their completed credits (with at least grade B or 70% marks in each course) to DIU. The student should submit a transcript provided by the university he/she is transferring from along with an application to the Program Coordinator/Head of the department/Dean of the faculty for accreditation. Their transcripts of records must match the course(s) they are transferring to DIU and are also taught at the University. There is an equivalence committee in each faculty. This committee decides and approves which courses will be exempted or how many credits will be accepted.

The student should not have been expelled for disciplinary reasons from the university he/she is transferring from.

## Equivalence Committee

There is an Equivalence Committee for determining the fitness of a student (from another institution/university) seeking admission to DIU. The Committee evaluates the academic documents and passes opinions regarding the eligibility for admission to a program in DIU.

## Attendance

Attendance is regarded as a part of the course requirements. The expected attendance is 90 percent of classes held. A student may be debarred from appearing at the course final examination if his/her attendance falls below 75 percent. Students are given marks on class attendance.



## Admission of International Students

International students meeting equivalent admission qualifications are eligible for admission as regular students or as special students for a part of the duration and may acquire transfer credits. In case of the latter, the recommended minimum duration of residence in the first year and the second year is one semester. The University may enroll foreign students under an exchange program established between DIU and students' concerned University.

Admission is also open to all who wish to pursue courses or a course as a non-degree student to improve knowledge or acquire new skills. Students are also admitted for a specific certificate or diploma courses.

## Drop/Add Procedure

Courses add/drop is allowed on or before the date of late registration. Within this period students can add/drop courses with the consent of the course advisor which is finally approved by the Head of the Department. In case of adding a course, at first the advisor makes sure that space is available in that course. No add/drop courses are allowed after the last date of late registration except for some special cases with valid reason but no tuition fee refund will be provided, and the student will also have to pay full tuition and other fees when he/she will register for that course(s) in the next Semester. No grade shall be shown in the 'Academic Transcript/Grade Report' for dropped course(s) but 'W' shall be shown for the withdrawn Course(s) in the 'Academic Transcript/Grade Report'. However, 'W' will not be incorporated while calculating GPA and CGPA. If the last day of the first two-weeks from the commencement of a Semester or, if the last day of the consecutive two weeks after the first two-weeks from the commencement of a Semester falls on Friday/Holiday, the students will have to apply on the day before that Friday/Holiday for availing opportunities mentioned above.

## Selecting the Major

The students are advised to choose their major no later than the first semester of the third year. Before going to choose the major, they should try to complete all the courses of the 2nd year level and take the opinion of the Academic Advisor.

## Student Dismissal

Students are dismissed from the program for failure to make satisfactory academic progress. Students failing to maintain the required CGPA (2.0) in two consecutive semesters will be dropped out of the program. Students dropped out of the program may appeal to the Dean/Head of the Department/Coordinator for re-admission. Re-admission will not be granted without strong evidence of significant change in student's ability to complete the requirements satisfactorily.



## Teaching Method and Medium

The University follows modern teaching methods including class lectures, interactive discussion, simulation, lab work, case analysis, and field study. A special feature of Daffodil International University teaching is the tutorial/workshop/lab sessions designed to assist students in learning application of concepts and theories. The medium of instruction at Daffodil International University is English.

## Additional Facilities for Weak Students

Many students joining the university may be coming from Bangla medium colleges and, therefore, would have to adjust with English as the medium of instruction. They may be asked to attend English courses rigorously and special English courses in Summer Semester or any other time preceding the semester in which they take regular courses. Similarly, students from non-science backgrounds or who are weak in Mathematics may be asked to attend a remedial course in Mathematics.

## Recognition of Outstanding Performance

A full-time student securing GPA 3.75 at the end of a regular semester will be included in the Dean's Honor List and for maintaining CGPA 3.75 in successive 3rd and 4th semesters, he/she will be placed in the VC's Honor List. A student in the VC's Honor List will be given individual citation. Students passed with CGPA 3.9 will receive Chancellor Award.

## Grading and Performance Evaluation process

The final grade in each course will be given on the basis of the performance in class attendance, quizzes, assignments, presentation, midterm test, and final examination as indicated below:

A student may earn any of the five-letter grades based on his/her performance in a course. The letter grades A+ to D are considered passing grades. Grade F is the failing grade. The numerical equivalents of the grades and grade points are given below:

## Grade Report

Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of a student is (numerical value) obtained by dividing the weighted grade points by the credit hours taken. Only the courses graded A+, A, A-, B+, B, B-, C+, C and D are used to determine credits. In case students repeat courses, GPA and CGPA will be calculated on the higher grade obtained in the courses. Grades obtained in course (s) in all examinations will be shown in the grade report.

### The Incomplete Grade:


The 'Incomplete' (I) grade is used in special circumstances. The 'Incomplete' may be given only at the end of a semester to a student who has completed all other requirements except that he did not in the final examination.

The student has the responsibility to take initiative in making up the Incomplete examination. If the incomplete examination is not completed in the make-up examination, which will be held after the publication of the semester result, then 'I' grade will automatically be converted into "F". If there is any repetition, it may be due to unfair means in the examination or for some reason the result is shown as 'W'. If the case is not settled in time, then 'W' will be automatically converted to 'F'.

### Academic Probation:

A student must maintain a good academic standing with a CGPA of at least 2.50. Students with CGPA and (or) GPA of less than 2.50 will be placed on Probation. Students on Probation will be allowed a maximum of three semesters to upgrade CGPA and (or) GPA minimum 2.50, failing which the student will be dropped from the program.





### Retake Policy:

A course passed with a grade B or below in any particular course, he/she may be allowed to repeat the course to improve the relevant grade. Students failing in a course, will be allowed to repeat that course twice at the most. In all cases normal course fees will have to be paid to the university.

### Appeal for any Unsatisfactory Result:

A student not satisfied with the grade in any course may appeal to the course teacher. But if the grade remains the same and the student remains unsatisfied, s/he may make a written request to the Head of the department or Dean of the faculty for re-examination of the script. On re-examination of the answer script, the revised final grade will be delivered. These procedures must be done within two weeks after the result was published. Before making an appeal, the student will have to make a payment of fee as determined by the university authority.

### Class Tests and Assignments:

Class Tests are taken in class hour or tutorial hour. The duration of a class test will be 15 to 20 minutes. Assignments may be done in class/tutorial hour/as homework.

### Midterm Examination:

Midterm Examination is held in the week announced in the Semester Calendar. The duration of the midterm exam is one hour and 30 minutes.

### Final Examination:

Final Examination will be held as announced in the Semester Calendar by the university. The duration of the final exam is 2 hours. But the final examination of bi-semester department will be 2 hours and 30 minutes.

### Fairness in Class Tests, Examinations, etc:

1. Students are forbidden from adopting unfair means in assignments, class tests, midterm and final examinations, project work, term papers, etc. The following acts or activities shall be considered unfair means during examinations and in other contexts:

- communicating with fellow students for obtaining help; (For example, talking, eye contact, signaling, body language etc.),
- copying from another student's script or report or paper,
- copying from printed matter, hand-written script, writing on desk or palm of hand, or from other incriminating documents,
- possession of any incriminating document, whether used or not,
- any approach in direct or indirect form to influence a teacher concerning grade, and
- any other unruly behavior which is disruptive of the academic program.

2. If a student is found adopting or has adopted unfair means, he/she may be asked to sit for an improvement examination or retake the course or expelled for one or more semesters depending on the magnitude of the offence. Adoption of unfair means may result in the dismissal of the student from the program and expulsion of the student from the university.

### Make up Class Tests:

Students are required to attend all class tests, assignments and examinations as announced in the university schedule. There is no Make-up for class tests and assignments.

## Make up of Midterm and Final Examination:

For the make-up of Midterm and Final Examination students need to register themselves in the department for the examination. Date of make-up examination will be announced by the examination committee in time. A student seeking make-up examination must pay the make-up exam fee at the prevailing rate. After completing these formalities, the student shall watch for the schedule of mid-term make-up exam or final make-up exams and sit for the exam. Midterm make-up exam is held within 10 days at the end of the midterm examinations and the make-up final exam is held within 3 weeks after publication of the results of the final examinations. If a student misses the schedule, he/she will have to retake the course.

## CGPA calculation:

The formula for calculating GPA (Grade Point Average) or CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) is  $CGPA = (\sum C_i \times G_i) / (\sum C_i)$  where  $C_i$  considered as credit and  $G_i$  considered as grade point.



In the Transcript CGPA has been calculated for the courses taken only at DIU. Credit Transfer courses are not included for calculating CGPA. Only the total number of transferred credits will be shown separately in the transcript to prove the completion of their requirement for the degrees.

## Examination Guideline

- Students must put their ID cards properly.
- They must bring their admit cards. A student shall not be allowed to sit for the exams without an admit card.
- Students must be sure that the Registrar signs the permit before the exam starts.
- Students must keep handbags, books, notebooks, mobile phones and things except permitted materials and examination documents in front of the room.
- Students, if found with any act of cheating, shall be debarred from appearing at the said examination or all examinations to be decided by the Examination Committee.
- Candidates shall not leave the examination hall before one hour has passed.
- Students are not allowed to carry cell phones in the examination hall.
- Digital diary or programmable calculators are not allowed for use in the exam hall.
- Students must not write anything on the question paper, desk, chair, walls of the examination hall.
- Not more than one student can go outside the examination hall at a time.
- Students must sign in the attendance sheet before leaving the examination hall.
- Nobody will be allowed to enter the examination hall more than half an hour after the examination starts.
- Students may use an additional answer sheet if needed but she/he must write his/her ID number and other particulars clearly and get them attached with the original answer scripts duly signed by the invigilator.
- Candidates must observe silence and strict discipline in the examination hall.
- For any other matters pertaining to smooth conduct of examination not mentioned above, the decision of the invigilator/hall in charge shall be considered final.



## Examination Schedule

An examination schedule of one midterm test and final examination will be notified to the teachers and students within 3 weeks after commencing the classes every semester. Before that, a tentative schedule including the time frame, the 1st to the 3rd quizzes, one midterm test and final examination will be notified.

## Academic Standing of a Student

To remain in good standing, a student must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.50 in a semester. The GPA is calculated on the basis of the number of courses attempted, including the course(s) in which the student receives "F" grade, until he or she repeats the course(s) and the "F" grade is substituted by a passing grade.

## Academic Probation and Dismissals:

A student with a GPA of less than 2.50 in a semester is placed on probation and is allowed a maximum of two semesters to raise his/her GPA. A student who fails to achieve a GPA of 2.50 within two consecutive semesters may be allowed additional chances depending on the improvement made, may be asked to transfer to another degree program or may be dismissed from the university.

## Readmission:

Students who have been dismissed from the University for some academic reasons may apply for readmission. Such applications would be treated on an individual basis. However, upon readmission students may seek credit transfer for courses where they had earned a minimum of C+ grade before dismissal. Readmission is granted only once.

## Withdrawal from the Semester:

1. If a student who has not registered in a semester but is willing to drop a semester or more must apply to the respective Dean/Head. A registered student who wishes to drop a semester (dropping all courses for the semester) must do so within the deadline by contacting the Dean/Advisor of the respective Faculty. Dropping semesters will not be allowed after the deadline except in the case of verifiable non-academic hardships if granted by the appropriate authority of the University. The grade "F" is recorded for students who abandon their courses without officially dropping from a semester or from a course.

2. A student who has not yet registered in a semester and wishes to drop from the program for a semester or more, must apply to the Dean of the concerned Faculty stating the reason for dropping. The Dean may permit to drop the semester if the reason is acceptable.

3. A student who wishes to permanently drop from the program may do so by applying to the Dean of the concerned Faculty.

4. A student who did not formally drop from a program or is absent for 3 consecutive semesters and later on wants to register in courses will have to seek permission from the Dean and pay Taka 2,000.00 for each semester and Taka 5,000.00 for 3 consecutive semesters.



## Change of Degree Program:

Students seeking to change their Program must submit a written request to the respective Dean/through Head of the department. Upon recommendation from the Dean of the Faculty to which the student intends to transfer, the appropriate/relevant office of the university shall make the necessary changes in the student's record. Program changes may be done within the first two semesters only.

## Degree Requirements

1. To earn the degree, a student must:

- Successfully complete all the courses and earn credits required for the degree;
- Earn the minimum CGPA (2.50) required for the degree;
- Clear all dues and liabilities to the university.

2. An undergraduate student should complete his/her degree requirements within four years from the date of his/her first admission. A student of a master program should complete his/her degree requirements within the time duration of the course from the date of his/her first admission.

3. Students are responsible for fulfilling all the requirements of their respective degree programs within the deadline. They should consult their Academic Advisors in planning their course schedule and be familiar with DIU policies and procedures related to registration for courses and graduation requirements for their degrees.

4. If a student has completed the requirements for the degree, he/she should apply in the prescribed form to the Controller of Examinations for provisional, transcript and for applying for the main certificate in convocation by paying required fees.



## Code of Conduct for the students

DIU is committed to maintaining a proper academic environment in its premises. Students are expected, as enlightened members of the society, to be of good moral character and decent conduct. They should strictly observe the university rules of discipline, maintain honesty and punctuality and have respect for the right of others within the premises. Willful violation of these rules seriously destabilizes the academic environment and undermines the efforts of the University to impart high quality education. Followings are the areas of misconduct:

### Academic Misconducts are

- cheating in the examinations by any method or means,
- helping other students to cheat in the examinations,
- reproducing the work of others as one's own work,
- fabrication or the falsification of any information with the intent to deceive, and
- forgery, alteration or abuse of university documents, records, and identity cards.

### Social Misconduct

- Abusive or disorderly conduct,
- verbal, mental, physical, or sexual harassment,
- physical assault in any form,
- direct/ indirect threats of violence and
- participation in any activity that may disrupt any function of the university.

### Theft

Theft or misappropriation of university properties and materials possessions of stolen university property.

### Disobedience to Lawful Authority

Disobedience, interference, resistance, or failure to comply with the direction of authorized university personnel on duty and unauthorized entry.

### Property Damage

Willful damage or destruction of any property of the university.

### Dangers to Health and Safety

Smoking inside the university campus.

Possession, buying and selling or use of alcohol and drugs or any other illegal and objectionable items.

### Use of Cell Phone

All students must keep their cell phones switched off inside the classroom.

### Penalties for Misconduct

The following penalties and sanctions will be imposed on a student for violation of the code of conduct of the university:

- Cancellations of facilities (waiver, laptop etc.),
- Warning in the form of written or verbal notice,
- Cancellation of an examination and/or an assignment,
- Expulsion for one or more semesters,
- Expulsion from the university for life.

### Disciplinary Procedure

The Discipline Committee of the university examines the allegations of misconduct; takes evidence from both sides and recommends penalties to be imposed on the student if found guilty.


## Alumni Association

## Campus Radio


DIU has introduced an Internet Campus Radio of its own to increase interaction and activities among its students and teachers. Educational programs are relayed regularly.

### **Electrical Circuits Laboratory:**

This laboratory is equipped with various types of resistors, variable rheostat, inductor, capacitor, dc and ac power supplies. Switches, lamp boards, ammeters, voltmeters, clamp-on-meters, variacs, oscilloscopes, etc. Here students verify different electrical circuit and network theorems, e.g., KCL, KVL, mesh, node, thevenin's, maximum power transfer, superposition theorems, etc.

### **Analog Electronics Laboratory:**

This laboratory is well equipped with various types of analog trainer boards, oscilloscopes, dc power sources, function generators, multimeter, LCR meters. Besides, in this laboratory there are wide ranges of resistors. Capacitors, inductors, VRs, diode, transistor, MOSFET, analog ICs, etc. Students are engaged in doing experiments on the study of semiconductor device characteristics, voltage regulator circuit, rectifier circuit, adder, integrator and differentiator circuit using linear op-amp IC, minority carrier life-time measurement of LDR and LED. Besides, students build projects on CE/CC amplifiers, power amplifier, communication circuits such as Amplitude and Frequency Modulation and Demodulation circuit, PLL circuit, etc.

### **Digital Electronics Laboratory:**

This laboratory is featured with state-of-the-art laboratory equipment such as a digital trainer board, logic probe, IC tester, IC extractor, digital meters, data switches, and wide ranges of digital ICs of TTL and CMOS series. Students do laboratory experiments on designing combinational and sequential circuits. Besides, they build up projects on logic gates, digital voltmeter, digital timer, etc. This laboratory will be furnished with the FPGA training kit of Midas, Korea very soon.

### **Microprocessor & Interfacing Laboratory:**

This laboratory is established with an 8086 microprocessor trainer kit, Pentium IV microcomputer, memory and interface ICs and devices. Students do projects on microprocessor and pc based dc motor and stepper motor controls, control of different electrical appliances through relay, display different patterns on LED, seven-segment display and dot-matrix display.



## Measurement & Instrumentation Laboratory

This laboratory is equipped with various types of test and measurement instruments like galvanometer, ammeter, voltmeter, wattmeter, energy meter, solar panel, different types of transducer, etc. Students design and implement experiments on differential and instrumentation amplifier, universal voltmeter, power and energy measurement techniques.

## Industrial Electronics Laboratory

This is a newly established laboratory. Students mainly do experiments on the study of device characteristics of MOSFET, SCR, TRIAC, DIAC, UJT, PUT, etc. They also use PSPICE and MATLAB software packages to simulate various types of power electronics circuits e.g. inverter, buck and boost regulator, chopper driven circuits, etc.

## Control System Laboratory

This laboratory has been functioning using the PLC, analog and digital motor control, robot arm control, PID control, etc. At present, students are using 'Control System Toolbox' of MATLAB to study the Routh's Stability Criterion, Step response to a system of different orders and types, root locus, PID control and digital control, Lm and phase-angle diagram to find the error coefficient of a system for different types of input signals.

## Digital Signal Processing Laboratory

This laboratory has also been developed using the DSP training kit of Texas Instrument's TMS320Cxx. At present, students are doing experiments using 'Signal Processing Toolbox1' of MATLAB. They are doing experiments on sample sequence generation, noise cancellation of an image, study of FIR and MR filters, power spectrum analysis, .wav file processing, etc.

## Data Communication Laboratory

This laboratory has also been set up using the data communication trainer from Falcon, India. At the moment, students are doing experiments on AM, FM, PCM, QPSK, ASK, FSK, OMSK, BER calculation, TDM, TDMA, CDMA, etc. using 'Communication Toolbox1' of MATLAB.

## Computer Networks Laboratory

In this laboratory, there is a great number of PCs connected with LAN for 60 students. This laboratory is provided with Windows 2000 Professional Servers, NIC, Crimpers, twisted pair cables, RJ45 connectors, router, switches, hubs and other networking kits.





### Telecommunication Engineering Laboratory

This laboratory has been working since the summer 2006 semester for the use of the experimental kits from TIMS, Australia, U Technicals, UK and Falcon, India.

### Microwave Engineering Laboratory

This laboratory has started functioning from the summer 2006 semester and will be equipped with microwave communication trainers from U Technicals, UK and D'Lorenzo, Italy.

### Pharmacy Laboratory

The Department of Pharmacy has the following laboratory facilities, each adequately equipped with instruments, equipment, glassware chemicals to perform experiments defined in the curricula.

1. Inorganic and Physical Pharmacy Laboratory
2. Pharmacognosy and Phytochemistry Laboratory
3. Organic pharmacy and Medicinal Chemistry Laboratory
4. Physiology and Pharmacology Laboratory
