Prof. Aliar Hossain is an accomplished and resourceful international academic and policy leader with extensive expertise in Strategic Management, Good Governance, Political Economy, and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). He is the Head of Department at Northumbria University London. He also serves as an advisor and visiting professor at Daffodil Int. University (Dhaka & RAK).

He chaired SDG Goal 4 (Quality Education) under a UNITR-project funded initiative (2023/24) and brings strong capabilities in leadership, coaching, consultancy, and diplomatic training. He also actively contributes to both local and international conferences as a keynote speaker, guest speaker, and moderator. Aliar maintains an active global presence, regularly engaging with universities across the UK, Middle East, and South Asia, as well as think tanks, chambers of commerce, local governments, and business organizations. With extensive professional and academic experience, he is widely recognized as an international speaker on topics such as strategy, change management, the SDGs, leadership development, good governance, corporate culture, and CSR.
